

White Antelope Memorial/First Nations - Student Assistant Level IV
Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 Semester

Program Description: The White Antelope Memorial and First Nations Program seeks to assist American Indian students with the completion of their undergraduate degree. The WAM/First Nations Program delivers programming and services designed to support academic success for Native American students. The Program works with students through graduation. Program participants include in-state and out-of-state tribally enrolled Native American students.

Position: Provide academic support, advocacy and participates in planning and implementation of program services to support Native American and other diverse students in small groups, one-on-one as an academic coach, and through program coordination.

Job Responsibilities: Program coordination; Lead small groups, Caseload Management; Data Analysis for potential grants; Other duties as required.

Required Qualifications: A current graduate student at CU Boulder maintaining good standing in either a Master's or a Doctoral degree program, in a STEM field, either part-time or full-time. A background check is required

Preferred Qualifications: Experience working with underserved student populations, with special emphasis for Native American students, including classroom experience with inclusive pedagogy. Experience in data collection and analysis or willingness to learn. Group facilitation and public speaking skills.

Hours: 13 hours per week, flexible hours. Some weekend and evening hours required.

Hiring Hourly Wage: \$20.00 per hour

A candidate who can commit to working an entire academic year, (Fall-Spring-Summer) and for multiple years is preferable. To apply, send a letter of interest and resume via attachment to: Sue.Lentz@Colorado.edu

Benefits:

All Undergraduate and Graduate Student Positions are hired as Student Hourly, and are not eligible for tuition remission. Work Study is used, if awarded and available, but not required for hire.
