Congratulations! You have been selected to receive a \$4,000.00 CU Boulder First Generation Scholarship at the University of Colorado Boulder for the 2022-23 Academic Year. The award is renewable for up to 10 semesters total provided you fulfill the renewal conditions outlined in this letter (maximum semesters for transfer students are based on grade level). The amount of the First Generation Scholarship is [Amount].

The First Generation Scholarship Program is designed to promote, encourage, and support academic success while cultivating a thriving community on the CU Boulder campus. To work toward these goals, the Center for Inclusion and Social Change (CISC) provides a comprehensive program to assist you toward the completion of a baccalaureate degree by way of community building and academic support.

There are certain requirements to be eligible for this scholarship and its renewal in future years:

- To receive the full amount of the scholarship each fall and spring semester, you must attend full-time (12 credit hours). Students enrolled between 6-11 credit hours will receive a pro-rated amount of the scholarship in that semester.
- You must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) each year by February 15.
- You must meet the Office of Financial Aid's Satisfactory Academic Progress standards.
- You must meet all of the First Generation Program participation requirements in your first year.
- There will be a variety of events from which you will choose, in addition to one mandatory meeting each semester.
- Participation is required only in the first year.
