

Exemption from CU Science Discovery's Student Drop-off / Pick-up Policy

CU Science Discovery policy states that a participant's parent or legal guardian is required to check-in and check-out registrants at designated drop-off and pick-up locations, as indicated at the time of registration. This policy plays a large part in our stringent safety protocol and is intended for students of all ages.

A parent/guardian may request an exemption to this policy if:

- The student is in 6th-12th grade and:
 - o Will be arriving or departing the program alone
 - Will be biking or walking to and from the program location
 - Will be taking a bus or other alternative transportation to and from the program location

Please note: It is required, <u>regardless</u> of a policy exemption, for the parent/legal guardian of all participants to drop the participant off on the first day of the program.
