

## WASSESSMENTS

The speech and voice assessment involves perceptual and instrumental measurements. Assessments typically include stimulability testing (probing of possible therapeutic techniques) to determine response to intervention and recommendations for appropriate treatment. Goal selection is then a combined effort of an individual and his/her/their speech-language pathologist.

Here are some examples of areas that may be addressed:

- pitch
- resonance
- voice quality
- intonation (the rhythm of speech)
- rate (how fast or slow a person speaks)
  - volume/intensity
    - language
- speech sound production (articulation)
- pragmatics (social rules of communication)
