Four Written Assignments: 60% of grade (15% each)

For each of the written assignment dates listed in the schedule a three to four page hand written assignment will be due. Depending on the sociological theory under study each of the following criteria should be addressed in narrative format.

1. Describe a current social issue which involves the concept of social deviance. The following list is but a few of the possible issues:

Legal Abortion	Teen Suicide
Drunk Drivers	Campus Drug Abuse
Pornography	Homeless Men & Women
Religious Cults	Child Abuse
White Collar Crime	Rape

2. Identify and describe the theoretical concepts you plan to use to analyze the socially deviant issue.
3. Apply the theoretical concepts to the socially deviant issue. For example: What kind of social structures appear to be operating in the increase of rape rates (structural functional theory); or is faulty socialization affecting increases in juvenile delinquency? (interactionist theory).
4. Discuss any potential solutions to the issue based on your analysis.
5. Reference list to include sources utilized for written assignment such as popular and/or scholarly journal articles, newspapers, books, interviews, etc. The Textbook may certainly be utilized in the discussion of the theoretical concepts.

\* Five (5) points will be deducted daily for late papers unless student and instructor have discussed different arrangements prior to due date.
