

	 knowing and understanding the differences we all have. Don't take the "words" for granted. people are afraid of what they don't know or don't understand. We focus on differences and not can bring us together. Unintentional ignorance.
	- Reluctance to acknowledge the complexity of each person. For example: Suppose a person's ethnicity is Vietnamese but they were born and raised in Saudi Arabia. Is their culture Vietnamese
	or Saudi Arabian? - Some challenges with different cultures is Nationalism. For example: A member at roundtable mentioned they are Japanese and he was married to "white" woman. His marriage did not work
	out and was in the midst of a divorce. He called his mom and instead of getting support for his challenge he was told "See I told you, you should have married Japanese
	woman and your marriage would have been successful." He mentioned in Asian cultures that there are stigmas. For example: If your Chinese it's acceptable to marry someone from China
	and Korea, but it depends on if they want to marry someone from Vietnam and definitely not Japan.
	- Social hierarchy. An employee of FacMan for the residence halls said he feels they are treated as just the "help" and when their department has a potluck or celebratory meal of some kind the
	"management" does not sit with the "help" or non-management. It was mentioned by another member, that while we are all here for the students, true, but in order to make CU "World class"

System Staff council has worked on putting together data on other campus policies related to Parental Leave. System was scheduled to talk about the information with Kathy Nesbitt, however that has been delayed due to her busy schedule. UCSC will review the data and presentation at the retreat in August and put together a more comprehensive meeting with Kathy and Plan Administrators to discuss this plan later this fall. Discussion are ongoing with Kathy with regards to the Short term disability plan that is currently in place. The council was relayed the initial response from Kathy about changing the plan. Further discussions on this plan will also be incorporated into the meeting with Kathy and Plan administrators. The council discussed the Years of Service data issues and every campus had issues with the data. Denver/Anschutz campus didn't hold a YOS event and hasn't in several years. The data issues and the Denver/Anschutz campus not having YOS event has been relayed to Kathy for assistance with them. The council put forth names for officer nominations. The Vice Chair, Secretary and Treasurer positions were open for this next year. An electronic ballot was sent out to all council members. New officers will be announced in June. The council continued to work on our "Working Climate Survey", reviewing questions and fine tuning the survey. Questions need to create actionable items for the council to work on over the next year or two. The survey will be reviewed at the retreat in August to fine tune any last items and then it will be sent out to all staff on the four campuses in Mid-August. Data from the survey will be compiled and the council will work through it in September to set more targeted goals.
