- Payroll, Benefits, Retirement and Legislative (PBRL) Grace Maniscalco & Ian King
 - PBRL has been focusing on compensation as part of their goals for this year. In November we hosted Kelly Reel at our meeting to talk about the compensation framework work that HR has been doing. This work entails making more transparent the job families, levels and functional areas and the pay ranges associated with them by publishing this information for staff to access and see where they personally sit in relation to that information. We had a great meeting and learned a lot from Kelly and we were excited about the prospect of this information being released in January (and hopeful that something similar might be in the works for PRAs soon!). However, in December we heard from sources that the launch of this information had been delayed with no clear rescheduled date and this was deeply concerning to us in PBRL. Given this we reached out to Kelly to ask:
 - o Is there a new timeline for this project?
 - O Why is this delay happening?
 - We received the following information:
 - We have decided to move the timeline back a bit for publishing the university staff salary ranges. We have received feedback that a more formal communication plan and more robust training resources for employees, managers, and supervisors will be helpful. We are considering a variety of next steps including obtaining more involvement from HR senior leaders, developing training resources, developing a communication plan, and preparing additional support such as webinars, open office hours, and additional tools. We hope to have the plan and an updated timeline in the next few months. I'll keep you posted on any working groups/feedback groups as I'd welcome Staff Council PBRL participation in those.

• Through further questions we found that it is unlikely that anything will be published this semester. PBRL expressed their strong desire to be involved in working groups around this issue and we will keep you posted.
