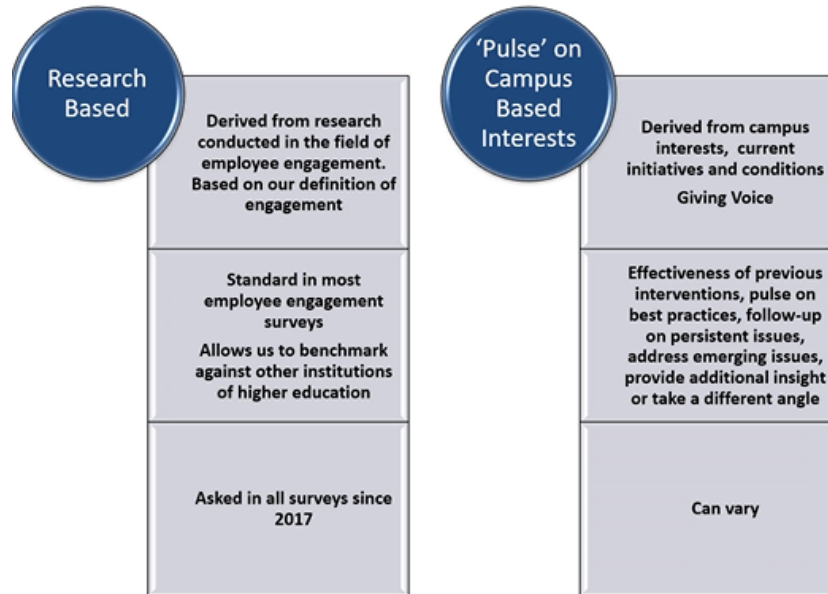
### Engagement Surveys Timeline



## About the Survey

- The Faculty and Staff Engagement survey is open **April 15-30, 2025**.
- **All CU Boulder staff and faculty with permanent appointments** will receive a survey invitation. Temporary employees and retirees will not receive a survey invitation.
- Results from the survey will be shared in **Summer/Fall 2025**.
- No one from CU Boulder will see individual survey results. Results will be grouped together and only reported at the unit level if **five or more respondents** responded. If a work group has fewer than five responses, results can be reported when combined with another group.
- The survey will take approximately **10 minutes** to complete.
- The survey will be translated into **five languages** (Spanish, Nepali, Lao, Simple Chinese, Tibetan).
- Survey results will allow us to **benchmark** against other higher education institutions, **track trending** data, and **create action plans** to change the work environment from the university, college, school, institute, division, or department level.
