### **Chair Report:**

- <u>CEC:</u> Chancellor has requested to meet two more times with Boulder Staff Council. Chairs are creating a list and ask committee chairs to add and comment on important issues and relevant topics, along with needs.
- Resolution process: Resolutions leaked before finalized. Need to watermark document and seek EC and then FC for comment before releasing documents. Chairs are working with K Erwin (Boulder CHRO Chief Human Resources Officer) who is offering guidance and feedback prior to releasing statements and resolutions. Note, once Google Drive link has been forwarded, anyone can access. Going forward, documents will be watermarked and have a process before being released.
- Mobility and flexibility of other governance on campus: Frustration that BFA (Boulder Faculty Assembly) and UCSG (CU Student Government) has ability to formalize statements and reactions more quickly than Staff Council.
- <u>Discussion:</u> Is Staff Council getting too political? How do we show concern and acknowledge issues while being conscientious of constituent's wants and needs? Do we need consensus? Ensuring that Staff Council is in alignment with our mission and vison and when to take a side versus being a neutral party. Focus this year on Parental Leave and the Tuition Benefit. Chairs aim is to pick conscientiously pick issues, get facts and bring issues to those who can take action.
