What is PSI CHI National Honor Society?

PSI CHI, a International Honor Society in Psychology, is an organization that requires outstanding academic achievement and provides opportunities for students to present ideas, interests, and research at a regional and national level. At the campus level, PSI CHI members have opportunities to connect with professors, explore new areas of psychology, conduct research, and play an active role in the operations and maintenance of the University of Colorado's PSI CHI chapter.

To join PSI CHI, students must meet particular academic criteria:

- *Completion of at least 3 semesters of college courses (36 credit hours)*
- *Transfer students must have completed at least 12 semester hours at CU Boulder*
- *Completion of at least 9 credit hours of psychology*
- *Undergraduates must have a cumulative GPA of no less than 3.0 and a psychology GPA of no less than 3.3 (not rounded up)*
- *Graduate students must have an average of "B" or better in all graduate courses in psychology*

Deadlines:

- Spring applications final deadline is **April 4**
***Certificates will be available for pick up in Fall 2020, we cannot mail them to you*
- If you wish to have your certificate this semester, applications must be submitted before **March 4**
