

The Teaching Quality Framework (TQF) Initiative Framework for Improved Evaluation. In an ideal evaluation system, a rubric grounded in scholarship around higher education, teaching and learning, and teaching evaluation should be utilized throughout the process (the TQF rubric can be found at: https://www.colorado.edu/teaching-quality-framework/TQFRubric). Multiple measures from multiple voices are used to collect data that align with the rubric; these measures are used for formative/developmental purposes in addition to summative assessment.
