CAMPUS / COMMUNITY RESOURCE

The UMC acts as a campus navigator for students, staff, faculty and the Boulder community. It's *the* place to get food and coffee, study, hang out, be involved, be yourself, reflect and connect to resources.

- A designated multicultural center, celebrating diversity through food, dance, art, music and the free exchange of ideas
- A center for activism and community interaction
- State of Colorado Veterans Memorial Lounge and showcase of artifacts from the USS *Colorado*
- A centralized campus office to reserve and produce a meeting or event in the UMC and in many other spaces across campus
- One of the largest ballrooms in Boulder, hosting local, national and international events – everything from weddings and retirement celebrations to world-renowned speakers, Conference on World Affairs, Coursera, Board of Regents and more
- The only bowling center in the city of Boulder, featuring 10 bowling lanes and five billiards tables
- A focus on sustainable practices in all areas of the facility, from waste diversion to resource conservation
- Multi-stall all-gender restrooms and single-stall family restrooms
- A student-operated program that provides free, safe night-time transportation for CU students, faculty and staff
- An art program displaying a wide variety of original artwork created by CU Boulder students
- Management of campus' EMS software for more than 1,500 spaces on campus
- Coordination of policy compliance for 700+ events with alcohol on campus
