 - 1. New refrigerators
 - iii. Mobile Pantry all of them were held last semester
 - 1. 40% staff attendance
 - 2. Two deliveries a week
 - 3. About 60% of students that attended were graduate and 40% are undergraduate

 - 1. Closed 99 cases of assistance in the fall

 - 3. \$22,000 of housing assistance offered
