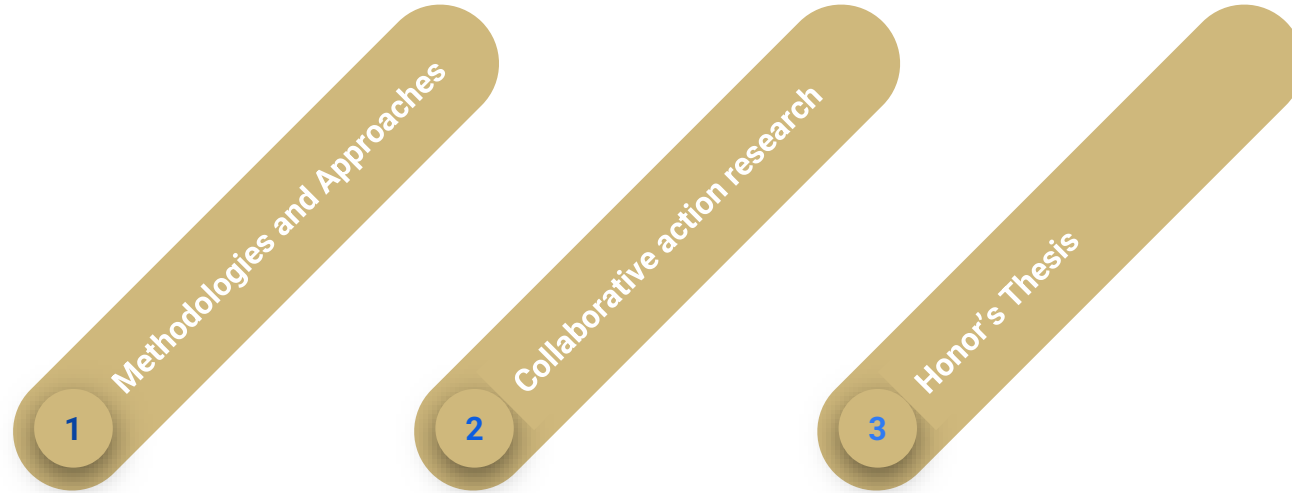

Pedagogical Approach



Program Overview



Year 1 (Sophomore Year)

- Seminar course with the full cohort
- Summer research immersion embedded in a research team for 10 weeks

Year 2 (Junior Year)

- Seminar course with the full cohort
- Independent study or hourly wage for 6–9 hours/week on a research team
- Identify honors thesis mentor and focal interest
- Summer research immersion embedded in lab and YPAR cohort for 10 weeks

Year 3 (Senior Year)

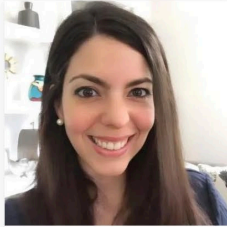
- Seminar course with the full cohort
- Independent mentored research project
- Capstone of honors thesis and oral defense
- Mentorship to support graduate school applications and grant submissions
- Opportunity to attend/present at a conference
