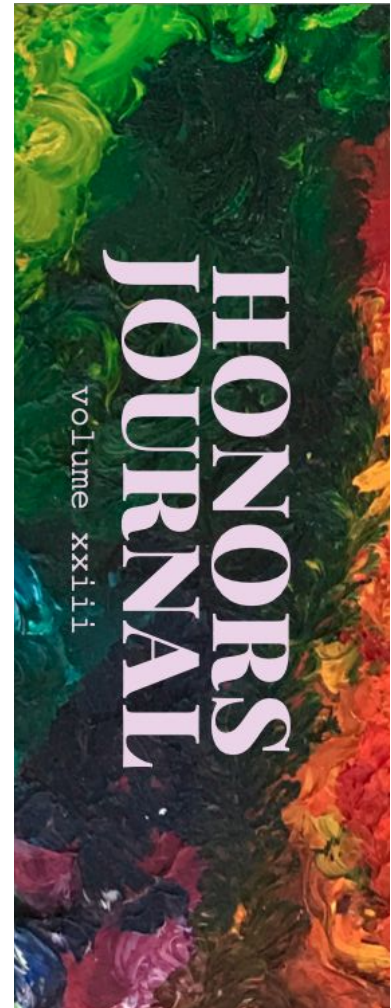

The interdisciplinary journal publishes writing, research, and creative work:

- ❖ Art - painting, ceramics, printmaking, sculpture, and more
- ❖ Creative nonfiction - creative writing based on the truth or a personal experience
- ❖ Fiction - creative writing in prose form (stories)
- ❖ Gender & ethnic studies - text-based, visual, performance, spoken word that addresses gender and racial-ethnic identity and/or oppression
- ❖ Humanities - literature, philosophy, history, art history, etc.

The interdisciplinary journal publishes writing, research, and creative work:

- ❖ Natural sciences - biology, ecology, physics, chemistry, etc.
- ❖ Open media - photos, recordings of performances, sheet music, digitally created art
- ❖ Poetry - creative writing in verse form & prose poems
- ❖ Social sciences - anthropology, sociology, international affairs, political science, economics, human geography, etc.

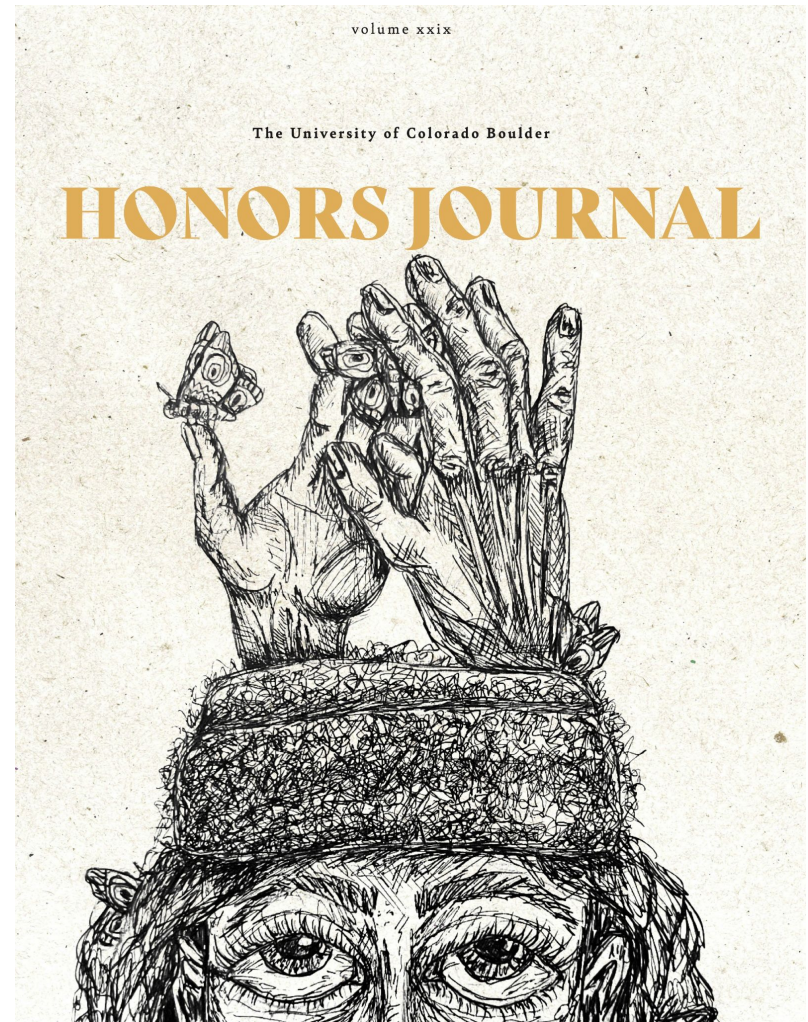


Get Involved in the Editorial Process
