

## **Conor Padraic McMahon USMC Scholarship**

The University of Colorado Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Scholarship Committee will select the recipient based on the listed criteria for a \$3,000 general scholarship for 2018-2019 school year, renewed annually for up to three years (six semesters). Applications deadline is July 5, 2019.

## Requirements

- 1. Active duty, reserve or honorably discharged from the United States Marine Corps (member 4 DD-214 required from veteran applicants).
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Accepted as a degree seeking undergraduate student at CU Boulder.
- 4. Earned at least 12 credits at CU Boulder.
- 5. FAFSA on file with the Office of Financial Aid.
- 6. Completed Conor Padraic McMahon USMC Scholarship Application.
- 7. A minimum 300 word essay explaining why you feel you are deserving of this scholarship. Submit as a Word document to stewart.elliott@colorado.edu.
- 8. One Recommendation Form from an individual who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship.
