CU Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Exhausted Benefits Scholarship

Veteran and Military Affairs will be offering a scholarship to veteran students that do not have eligibility under any VA benefit program. Applicants may receive a maximum of \$2000 per academic year. This scholarship is not renewable. An academic advisor or a faculty member with knowledge of the student's academic progress must submit a recommendation for an application to be considered. Information from their recommendation will be taken into account as part of the application.

Priority application deadline is July 1, 2021.

Requirements

1. Submit proof that all VA benefits are exhausted from Ebenefits or an award letter.
2. Must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
3. Must have completed more than 75% of current degree.
4. If selected, students are required to send a thank you note to the scholarship donor.
5. Student's academic advisor or a faculty member must submit a recommendation stating they believe student is making reasonable progress in their program.
