

## CU Boulder Veteran and Military Affairs Exhausted Benefits Scholarship

Veteran and Military Affairs will be offering a scholarship to veteran students that do not have eligibility under any VA benefit program, including Chapter 31 or the STEM Extension. Applicants may receive a maximum of \$2000 per academic year. This scholarship is not renewable. An academic advisor or a faculty member with knowledge of the student's academic progress must submit a recommendation for an application to be considered. Information from their recommendation will be take into account as part of the application.

## Requirements

- 1. Submit proof that all VA benefits are exhausted from Ebenefits or an award letter.
- 2. Must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- 3. Must have completed more than 75% of current degree.
- 4. If selected, students are required to send a thank you note to the scholarship donor.
- 5. Student's academic advisor or a faculty member must submit a recommendation stating they believe student is making reasonable progress in their program.
