- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 3. Accepted as a degree seeking undergraduate or graduate student at CU Boulder.
- 4. Completed at least one full-time semester at CU Boulder before Fall 2019.
- 5. FAFSA on file with the Office of Financial Aid.
- 6. Completed CU Boulder VMA Scholarship Application.
- 7. A minimum 300 word essay explaining how your military experience combined with your higher education will benefit your community. Submit as a Word document to stewart.elliott@colorado.edu.
- 8. One Recommendation Form from an individual who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship.
